Mignon believes that there is nothing more luminous than a bride on her wedding day. “One of my fondest memories of my wedding day is my mother placing a strand of pearls around my neck. LUZ is the Spanish word for light. I chose to name this new collection LUZ to describe the glow that surrounds a bride on her wedding day.” Mignon’s first foray into bridal, the collection is inspired by vintage insertion lace and includes jewelry designs, bandeaux, sash and wristlet.

“Gros Rouge” finish was used for the custom built table and armoire. This type of finish was used in historical Louisiana furnishings. The table is modeled after one of the oldest surviving pieces of Louisiana furniture, a refectory table made for the Ursuline Convent in the 1730’s.

The original chandelier is by local artist Julie Neill. Neill used Mignon’s Serpentine Jeweled Cuff, which pays homage to the roof-line ironwork of Le Petit Theatre in the French Quarter as a model for the chandelier. The steel frame is coated in four layers of hand applied silver leaf, and solid rock crystals are in place of the semi-precious chalcedony used in the jewelry design.

Mignon collaborated with David Waggoner of Waggoner & Ball Architects, to create a balance of traditional New Orleans materials mixed with modern architectural forms.

The custom cases and walls are walnut and pickled cypress. Cypress is an indigenous building material found along the Gulf Coast and used for building since the late 1800’s. The floor is Noir Stone, which references the traditional slate used in many historic New Orleans buildings.
